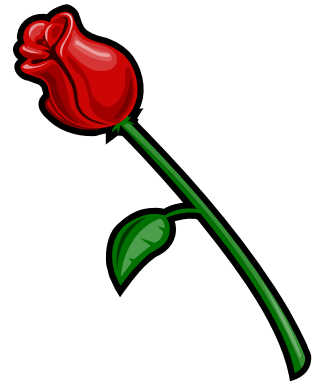
A Warm Welcome from Tanita
